
History of Glassblowing


Glassblowing is a very old art. It began about four thousand years ago in Mesopotamia (mehs-uh-puh-TAY-mee-uh).






The first popular use of glass was in ancient Rome. This is because the first metal pipe for blowing glass was invented in Rome. The Romans were able to make glass easily and skillfully.


A New World of Glass
