Why Volcanoes Happen

A volcano starts as a big, deep hole or crack in Earth's surface. When **pressure** builds, ash, rock, gas, and **magma** escape through the hole. In time, the escaped material can form a mountain.



Magma (MAG-muh) is hot, melted rock.
