Match the pictures to the text on the following page





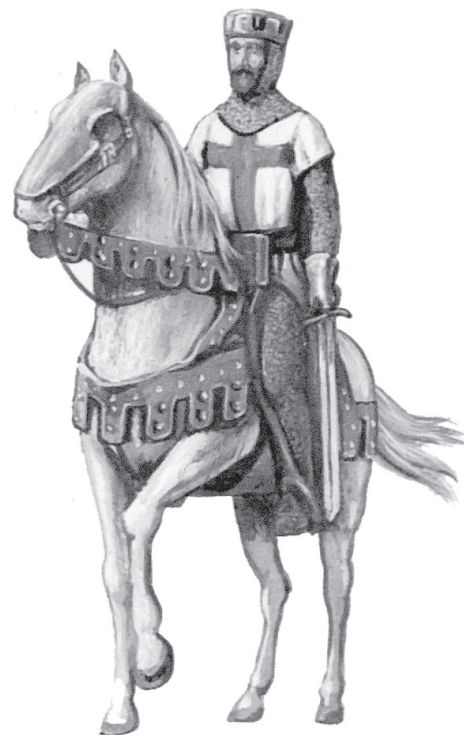
- 1| The night-watch patrolled the streets all night to make sure that everything was peaceful and that there was no fire.
